We seek to inspire our members to take action to support native organizations in our community.







 - PTSA possibly absorbing cost for IXL as supplement (does not provide data for district)




Treasurers Update

5th Grade 23-24 I-wood Grant	8,000	8,036
Total Income	\$301,540	\$286,256
Total Expenses	\$300,261	\$69,156

- Annual campaign funds in account: \$189,147
- ~22K in matching funds that we need confirmation for Annual Campaign vs library; expecting matching funds for library fundraiser and need to differentiate - Question: is Anthony still the POC? Not getting replies
- Budget has \$5K unallocated. The following are unexpected expenses (no change since last month):
 - Overdue taxes from 2020 \$239
 - Prior year expenses paid in current year -\$3,366 (buses, field trip)
 - Multicultural night \$450
 - FIN \$300 (approved last meeting)
 - If all of these are part of \$5K budget, we have balance of \$645


Legislative Updates: The Bryant PTSA supports the bills below.

- Votes due today. Continued controversy around BEX VI levy. Bryant PTSA does not have an official position but has been keeping community informed.


Highly capable services: To be discussed at Feb 12th SPS board meeting, some Seattle parents are organizing around it.
